

# BALTIC JUNIOR CUP OPEN 26.-27.09.2009 IN ESTONIA

## INVITATION

### GENERAL

Estonian Orienteering Federation and OK Võru are in 26.-27.09.2009 organizing annual junior teams competition Baltic Junior Cup. It is a team competition between 7 youth teams from Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, South-Sweden (Halland, Skåne, Blekinge), Småland and Swedish Orienteering Association in Finland. Every participating team consists of 5 runners in each of following classes: W16, M16, W18, M18, W20, M20. Team competition programme includes long distance and mixed relay races.

In connection to Baltic Junior Cup 2009 organizers announce an open individual 2-days competition **Baltic Junior Cup Open**.

Baltic Junior Cup Open participants are going to have good possibilities to follow the competition of youth teams and to meet challenges of same terrain and map.

### EVENT CENTRE AND COMPETITION CENTRES

Event centre is Haanjamehe tourist farm in Võru county, Haanja parish.

Võru is situated 250 km southeast from Tallinn and Haanjamehe farm is situated 15 km from Võru. More detailed information at <http://www.kubija.ee/haanjamehetalu/>

Competition centre both days will be at Haanjamehe farm.

### CLASSES AND COURSES

There will be 3 different open courses at BALTIC JUNIOR CUP Open:

Open 1 – lengths approx. 8 km on day 1 and 6 km on day 2.

Open 2 – lengths approx. 6 km on day 1 and 4 km on day 2

Open 3 – lengths approx. 4 km on day 1 and 3 km on day 2

Entries to Open courses are free for both male and female runners independently of their age.

### GENERAL TERRAIN DESCRIPTION

Mixed forest with coniferous trees dominating, plenty of marshes, quite big height differences (up to 83 m on one slope). Network of tracks and paths is rather dense. Runnability is varying from rather good to very bad.
