05. april **Letting-out-cattle-competition** (long distance).
Rõuge-Kiidi. Start at 13.00.
06. april **Easter middle distance**
Kiidi. Start at 10.00.

CATEGORIES:

MN*8NR**; MN10NR; MN12; MN14; MN16; MN18; MN21A; MN21B;
MN35; MN40; MN45; MN50; MN55; MN60; MN65
Courses of the day - 3 and 6 km, registration at the competition
centre.

The organiser has right to add together classes if there are less than 4
registered participants per class after the deadline for entries.

** - In NR-classes course is marked in the terrain with plastic ribbon and drawn on
the map, but marking is not following fastest route from control to control.)

TERRAIN AND MAP:

Variable South-Estonian terrain. Maximum height difference 40 metres
on one slope in south-western part of the map, undulating parts
varying with middle-sized marshes cover other parts of the map.
Runability ranges from poor to good, storm fallen trees occur. Network
of paths and roads is rather dense. Forest covered areas make up 70%
of the terrain.

Letting-out-cattle competition: MN8NR,10NR 1:7500; M21A, N21A
1:15000, all other categories 1:10000.

Easter middle distance: MN8NR,10NR 1:7500; all other categories
1:10000.

START TYPE:

At Letting-out-cattle competition there will be common start for classes M21A and N21A. Courses are forked, M21A course consists of 3 loops, N21A 1 loop with "butterfly".
In all other classes and at Easter middle distance there will be interval start.
